

## COLLEGE CREDITS FOR CLEE GRADUATES

The Law Enforcement Foundation has entered into agreements with two Ohio universities to provide graduate level credit for graduates of the CLEE program. The two higher education institutions are Tiffin University and Franklin University, Columbus.

### TIFFIN UNIVERSITY

A total of 9 semester hours of credit will be granted towards our Bachelor of Criminal Justice (BCJ) or Master of Science (MS) program if the student fulfills the requirements set out below:

1. The student must be admitted to the BCJ or MS program.
2. The student must complete the entire CLEE program and submit a copy of the certificate to Tiffin University.
3. The student will need to submit their collection of CLEE documentation (10-15 papers completed during CLEE) and/or write one 10-12 page paper on an assigned topic related to the Tiffin University courses for assessment of credit.
4. Students awarded Undergraduate (BCJ) CLEE credit waives Graduate (MS) credit eligibility.
5. The student must pay \$100/per course for a total of \$300 for the 9 semester hours of credit.
6. The assigned faculty member will be paid \$150 to review the paper.
