Golden Ticket Program

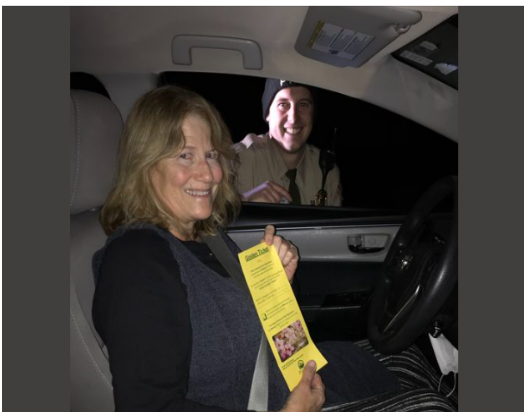
Officers issue Golden Tickets to citizens who are “caught” doing good things in the community. These citizens receive a Walmart gift card as a reward.

The Department assists a local homeowners association in holding a bike parade through a township park. Free food is provided.

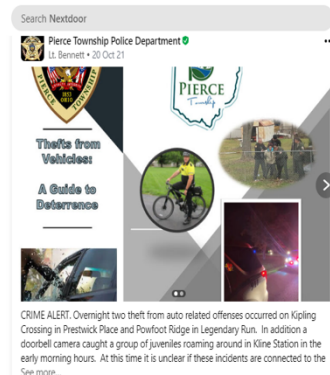
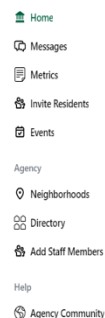


Social Media Updates
